# Part 53 - Forms

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53.300 Listing of Standard, Optional, and Agency forms.

Parent topic: Federal Acquisition Regulation

## 53.000 Scope of part.

This part—

- (a) Prescribes standard forms (SF's) and references optional forms (OF's) and agency-prescribed forms for use in *acquisition*; and
- (b) Contains requirements and information generally applicable to the forms.

## 53.001 Definitions.

*Exception*, as used in this part, means an approved departure from the established design, content, printing specifications, or conditions for use of any standard form.

# **Subpart 53.1 - General**

## 53.100 Scope of subpart.

This subpart contains requirements and information generally applicable to the forms prescribed in this regulation.

## 53.101 Requirements for use of forms.

The requirements for use of the forms prescribed or referenced in this part are contained in <u>parts 1</u> through  $\underline{52}$ , where the subject matter applicable to each form is addressed. The specific location of each requirement is identified in <u>subpart 53.2</u>.

#### 53.102 Current editions.

The form prescriptions in <u>subpart 53.2</u> and the FAR forms located at <u>https://www.gsa.gov/forms</u> contain current edition dates. *Contracting officers shall* use the current editions unless otherwise authorized under this regulation.

## 53.103 Exceptions.

Agencies shall not-

- (a) Alter a standard form prescribed by this regulation; or
- (b) Use for the same purpose any form other than the standard form prescribed by this regulation without receiving in advance an *exception* to the form.

## 53.104 Overprinting.

Standard and optional forms (obtained as required by  $\underline{53.107}$ ) may be overprinted with names, addresses, and other uniform entries that are consistent with the purpose of the form and that do not alter the form in any way. *Exception* approval for overprinting is not needed.

## 53.105 Computer generation.

- (a) The forms prescribed by this part may be computer generated without exception approval (see 53.103), provided-
- (1) There is no change to the name, content, or sequence of the data elements, and the form carries the Standard or Optional Form number and edition date (see 53.111); or
- (2) The form is in an electronic format covered by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) X12 Standards published by the Accredited Standards Committee X12 on *Electronic Data Interchange* or a format that can be translated into one of those standards.
- (b) The standards listed in paragraph (a)(2) of this section may also be used for submission of data set forth in other parts for which specific forms have not been prescribed.

## 53.106 Special construction and printing.

Contracting offices may request exceptions (see 53.103) to standard forms for special construction and printing. Examples of common exceptions are as follows:

Standard Forms	Special Construction and Printing
(a) <u>SF 18</u> -	(1) With vertical lines omitted (for listing of <i>supplies</i> and services, unit, etc.);
	(2) As reproducible masters; and/or
	(3) In carbon interleaved pads or sets.
(b) SF's <u>26</u> , <u>30</u> , <u>33</u> , <u>1447</u> -	As die-cut stencils or reproducible masters.
(c) <u>SF 44</u> -	(1) With serial numbers and contracting office name and address; and/or
	(2) On special weight of paper and with the type of <i>construction</i> , number of sets per book, 2 and number of parts per set as specified by the <i>contracting officer</i> . ( <i>Executive agencies may</i> supplement the administrative instructions on the inside front cover of the book.)

- (d) SF 1442- (1) As die-cut stencils or reproducible masters; and/or
  - (2) With additional wording as required by the *executive agency*. (However, the sequence and wording of the items appearing on the prescribed form *should* not be altered.

## 53.107 Obtaining forms.

Executive agencies shall obtain standard and optional forms from the General Services Administration (GSA) Forms Library at  $\underline{\text{https://www.gsa.gov/forms}}$ . Agency forms are available from the prescribing agency.

## 53.108 Recommendations concerning forms.

Users of this regulation *may* recommend new forms or the revision, elimination, or consolidation of the forms prescribed or referenced in this regulation. Recommendations from within an *executive agency shall* be submitted to the cognizant council in accordance with agency procedures. Recommendations from other than *executive agencies should* be submitted directly to the FAR Secretariat.

## 53.109 Forms prescribed by other regulations.

Certain forms referred to in <u>subpart 53.2</u> are prescribed in other regulations and are specified by the FAR for use in *acquisition*. For each of these forms, the prescribing agency is identified by means of a parenthetical notation after the form number. For example,  $\underline{SF 1165}$ , which is prescribed by the Government Accountability Office (GAO), is identified as  $\underline{SF 1165}$  (GAO).

#### 53.110 Continuation sheets.

Except as may be otherwise indicated in the FAR, all standard forms prescribed by the FAR may be continued on (a) plain paper of similar specification, or (b) specially constructed continuation sheets (e.g., OF336). Continuation sheets shall be annotated in the upper right-hand corner with the reference number of the document being continued and the serial page number.


#### 53.111 Contract clause.

Contracting officers shall insert the clause at 52.253-1, Computer Generated Forms, in solicitations and contracts that require the contractor to submit data on Standard or Optional Forms prescribed by this regulation; and, unless prohibited by agency regulations, forms prescribed by agency supplements.

## **Subpart 53.2 - Prescription of Forms**

## 53.200 Scope of subpart.

This subpart prescribes standard forms and references optional forms and agency-prescribed forms for use in *acquisition*. Consistent with the approach used in <u>subpart 52.2</u>, this subpart is arranged by subject matter, in the same order as, and keyed to, the parts of the FAR in which the form usage requirements are addressed. For example, forms addressed in FAR <u>part 14</u>, Sealed Bidding, are treated in this subpart in section <u>53.214</u>, Sealed Bidding; forms addressed in FAR <u>part 43</u>, *Contract Modifications*, are treated in this subpart in section <u>53.243</u>, *Contract modifications*. The following example illustrates how the subjects are keyed to the parts in which they are addressed:

- (b) *DD Form 441(DoD), Security Agreement.* (See paragraph (b) of the clause at <u>52.204-2</u>.)

#### 53.205-1 Paid advertisements.

 $\underline{\text{SF }1449}$  , prescribed in  $\underline{53.212}$  , shall be used to place orders for paid advertisements as specified in  $\underline{5.503}$  .

#### **53.209-1** Responsible prospective contractors.

The following forms are prescribed for use in conducting preaward surveys of prospective contractors, as specified in 9.106-1, 9.106-2, and 9.106-4. These forms are authorized for local reproduction and can be found at the GSA Forms Library at <a href="https://www.gsa.gov/forms">https://www.gsa.gov/forms</a>.

- (a) <u>SF 1403</u> (Rev. 01/2014), Preaward Survey of Prospective Contractor (General).
- (b) <u>SF 1404</u> (Rev. 01/2014), Preaward Survey of Prospective Contractor-Technical.

## 53.212 Acquisition of commercial products and commercial services.

 $\underline{SF\ 1449}$  (Rev. Nov 2021), Solicitation/Contract/Order for Commercial Products and Commercial Services .  $\underline{SF\ 1449}$  is prescribed for use in solicitations and contracts for commercial products and commercial services. Agencies may prescribe additional detailed instructions for use of the form.

# 53.213 Simplified acquisition procedures (SF's 18, 30, 44, 1165, 1449, and OF's 336, 347, and 348).

The following forms are prescribed as stated in this section for use in *simplified acquisition* procedures, orders under existing contracts or agreements, and orders from required sources of *supplies* and services:

- (a) <u>SF 18</u> (Rev.6/95), Request for Quotations, or <u>SF 1449</u> (Rev. Nov 2021), Solicitation/Contract/Order for Commercial Products and Commercial Services. <u>SF 18</u> is prescribed for use in obtaining price, cost, delivery, and related information from suppliers as specified in <u>13.307(b)</u>. <u>SF 1449</u>, as prescribed in <u>53.212</u>, or other agency forms/automated formats, *may* also be used to obtain price, cost, delivery, and related information from suppliers as specified in 13.307(b).
- (b) <u>SF 30</u> (Rev.11/2016), Amendment of Solicitation/ Modification of Contract. <u>SF 30</u>, prescribed in 53.243, may be used for modifying purchase orders, as specified in 13.307(c)(3).
- (c)  $\underline{SF\ 44}$  (Rev.10/83), Purchase Order Invoice Voucher.  $\underline{SF\ 44}$  is prescribed for use in simplified acquisition procedures, as specified in  $\underline{13.306}$ .
- (d) <u>SF 1165</u> (6/83Ed.), Receipt for Cash-Subvoucher. <u>SF 1165</u> (GAO) may be used for imprest fund purchases, as specified in <u>13.307</u>(e).
- (e) <u>OF 336</u> (4/86Ed.), Continuation Sheet. <u>OF 336</u>, prescribed in 53.214(h), may be used as a continuation sheet in *solicitations*, as specified in 13.307(c)(1).
- (f) <u>SF 1449</u> (*Rev. Nov 2021*) Solicitation/Contract/Order for Commercial Products and Commercial Services prescribed in <u>53.212</u>, <u>OF 347</u> (Rev.2/2012), Order for Supplies or Services, and <u>OF 348</u> (Rev.4/06), Order for Supplies or Services-Schedule Continuation. <u>SF 1449</u>, OF's <u>347</u> and <u>348</u> (or approved agency forms/automated formats) *may* be used as follows:
- (1) To accomplish acquisitions under simplified acquisition procedures, as specified in 13.307.
- (2) To establish blanket purchase agreements (BPA's), as specified in  $\underline{13.303-2}$ , and to make purchases under BPA's, as specified in  $\underline{13.303-5}$ .
- (3) To issue orders under basic ordering agreements, as specified in 16.703(d)(2)(i).
- (4) As otherwise specified in this chapter (e.g., see 5.503(a)(2), 8.406-1, 36.701(b), and 51.102(e)(3)(ii)).

## 53.214 Sealed bidding.

The following forms are prescribed for use in *contracting* by sealed bidding (except for *construction* and *architect-engineer services*):

- (a) <u>SF 26</u> (Rev. 12/2022), Award/Contract. <u>SF 26</u> is prescribed for use in awarding sealed bid contracts for *supplies* or services in which bids were obtained on <u>SF 33</u>, Solicitation, Offer and Award, as specified in 14.408-1(d)(1). Block 18 may only be used for sealed-bid procurements.
- (b)  $\underline{SF\ 30}$ , Amendment of Solicitation/Modification of Contract.  $\underline{SF\ 30}$ , prescribed in  $\underline{53.243}$ , shall be used in amending invitations for bids, as specified in  $\underline{14.208}$ (a).
- (c) <u>SF 33</u> (*Rev.* 12/2022), Solicitation, Offer and Award. <u>SF 33</u> is prescribed for use in soliciting bids for *supplies* or services and for awarding the contracts that result from the bids, as specified in 14.201-2(a)(1), unless award is accomplished by <u>SF 26</u>.
- (d) <u>SF 1447</u> (Rev. 12/2022), Solicitation/Contract. <u>SF 1447</u> is prescribed for use in soliciting supplies or services and for awarding contracts that result from the bids. It shall be used when the simplified contract format is used (see 14.201-9) and may be used in place of the <u>SF 26</u> or <u>SF 33</u> with other solicitations and awards. Agencies may prescribe additional detailed instructions for use of the form.
- (e) [Reserved]
- (f) <u>SF 1409</u> (Rev. 9/88), Abstract of Offers, and <u>SF 1410</u> (9/88), Abstract of Offers-Continuation. <u>SF 1409</u> and <u>SF 1410</u> are prescribed for use in recording bids, as specified in 14.403(a).
- (g) <u>OF 17</u> (Rev. 12/93), Offer Label. <u>OF 17</u> may be furnished with each invitation for bids to facilitate identification and handling of bids, as specified in <u>14.202-3</u>(b).
- (h) OF 336 (Rev.3/86), Continuation Sheet. OF 336 may be used as a continuation sheet in solicitations, as specified in 14.201-2(b).

#### 53.215 Contracting by negotiation.

#### 53.215-1 Solicitation and receipt of proposals.

The following forms are prescribed, as stated in the following paragraphs, for use in *contracting* by negotiation (except for *construction*, *architect-engineer services*, or *acquisitions* made using *simplified acquisition procedures*):

- (a) <u>SF 26</u> (Rev.3/2013), Award/Contract. <u>SF 26</u>, prescribed in <u>53.214</u>(a), may be used in entering into negotiated contracts in which the *signature* of both parties on a single document is appropriate, as specified in <u>15.509</u>. Block 18 may not be used for negotiated *procurements*.
- (b) <u>SF 30</u> (Rev.11/2016), Amendment of Solicitation/Modification of Contract. <u>SF 30</u>, prescribed in 53.243, may be used for amending requests for proposals and for amending requests for information, as specified in 15.210(b).
- (c) <u>SF 33</u> (Rev.9/97), Solicitation, Offer and Award. <u>SF 33</u>, prescribed in <u>53.214</u>(c), may be used in connection with the solicitation and award of negotiated contracts. Award of such contracts may be

made by either OF 307, SF 33, or SF 26, as specified in 53.214(c) and 15.509.

- (d) <u>OF 17</u> (Rev.12/93), Offer Label. <u>OF 17</u> may be furnished with each request for proposals to facilitate identification and handling of proposals, as specified in <u>15.210</u>(c).
- (e) <u>OF 307</u> (Rev.8/2016), Contract Award. <u>OF 307</u> may be used to award negotiated contracts as specified in <u>15.509</u>.
- (f) <u>OF 308</u> (Rev.9/97), Solicitation and Offer-Negotiated Acquisition. <u>OF 308</u> may be used to support solicitation of negotiated contracts as specified in <u>15.210</u>(a). Award of such contracts may be made by <u>OF 307</u>, as specified in <u>15.509</u>.
- (g) <u>OF 309</u> (Rev.9/97), Amendment of Solicitation. <u>OF 309</u> may be used to amend solicitations of negotiated contracts, as specified in <u>15.210(b)</u>.

- (1) Construction, alteration, or repair; or
- (2) Dismantling, demolition, or removal of improvements, as specified in 36.701(b).
- (f) <u>OF 1419(11/88Ed.)</u>, Abstract of Offers-Construction, and <u>OF 1419A</u> (11/88Ed.), Abstract of Offers-Construction, Continuation Sheet. OF's <u>1419</u> and <u>1419A</u> are prescribed for use in recording bids (and *may* be used for recording proposal information), as specified in <u>36.701(c)</u>.

#### 53.236-2 Architect-engineer services (SF's 252 and 330).

The following forms are prescribed for use in *contracting* for architect-engineer and related services:

<u>SF 30</u>, Amendment of Solicitation/Modification of Contract. <u>SF 30</u>, prescribed in 53.243, shall be used in connection with novation and change of name agreements, as specified in 42.1203 (h).

#### 53.243 Contract modifications (SF 30).

 $\underline{SF\ 30}$  (Rev.11/2016), Amendment of Solicitation/ Modification of Contract.  $\underline{SF\ 30}$  is prescribed for use in amending invitation for bids, as specified in  $\underline{14.208}$ ; modifying purchase and delivery orders, as specified in  $\underline{13.302-3}$ ; and modifying contracts, as specified in  $\underline{42.1203}$ (h),  $\underline{43.301}$ ,  $\underline{49.602-5}$ , and elsewhere in this regulation. The form may also be used to amend solicitations for negotiated contracts, as specified in  $\underline{15.210}$  (b). Pending the publication of a new edition of the form, Instruction (b), Item 3 (effective date), is revised in paragraphs (3) and (5) as follows:

- (b) Item3 (effective date).
