22.403-3 Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards.

40 U.S.C.chpater 37, Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards, requires that certain contracts (see $\underline{22.305}$) contain a clause (see $\underline{52.222-4}$) specifying that no laborer or mechanic doing any part of the work contemplated by the contract *shall* be required or permitted to work more than 40 hours in any workweek unless paid for all additional hours at not less than 1 1/2 times the basic rate of pay (see $\underline{22.301}$).
